INSTALLATION OF OCEANOGRAPHIC MEASURING EQUIPMENT

SOUTH GIPPSLAND – WILSONS PROMONTORY

DATE: With immediate effect.

DETAILS: Mariners are advised that Oceanographic measuring equipment has been installed at various locations in the vicinity of the Wilsons Promontory coast.
The equipment is marked with small yellow buoys and lit with strobe lights.
The initial deployments will be located at the approximate positions:

1.	Sealers Cove	Lat -39 04.43'	Long 146 7.926'
2.	Waterloo Bay	Lat -39 04.263'	Long 146 6.283'
3.	Norman Point	Lat -30 03.292'	Long 146 8.811'
4.	Tongue Point	Lat -38 59.124'	Long 146 4.866'

CHARTS The buoys will be relocated when the data capture is complete.
